

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Abstracts should be submitted electronically as a word file. They should consist of a title, followed by the author's names and the respective institution (without postal address) as well as the text. The text body should be limited to 500 words and should be structured into sections with separate headings including hypothesis/objectives, methods, results and conclusions. Abstracts must represent original material not previously published in a peer-reviewed journal. Papers previously presented at other scientific meetings, but not yet in print, will be considered.

At the bottom of the abstract, the corresponding author should be stated providing the full name with academic degree, the affiliation, the complete postal address as well as phone and fax numbers and the e-mail address.

OUTSTANDING INVESTIGATOR AWARD

The faculty will select the most outstanding abstract for a prize of \$250 and complimentary registration for the 2011 conference.
